THE ABC OF KI

The Australian sea-lions at **Seal Bay** are living the Australian lifestyle – a great seafood diet, stretching out on a white sandy beach before heading out for a quick surf. The colony of around 1000 animals live on the beach year-round and are accustomed to visitors, offering an experience reminiscent of the Galapagos.

Roughly a million **Kangaroo Island kangaroos and tamar wallabies** bound around the 'zoo with no fences'. The two macropods are both sub-species endemic to the island and whilst nationally classified as endangered, their local abundance enables easy observation of them in the wild.

The **Remarkable Rocks** is a collection of wind carved granite tors on an isolated clifftop, an extraordinary contemporary sculpture park, entirely of nature's making! The combination of unique shapes, vivid colours and a rugged outlook provides a wonderful setting for exploring, photography, quiet contemplation or – for the young or imaginative – a wonderful natural playground.

The south-west promontory of **Cape du Couedic** accepts the full force of the Southern Ocean and the relentless waves have smoothed hard rock into ledges perfect for fur-seals. Over the top, a stalactite encrusted sea cave known as Admirals Arch provides a spectacular frame. The lighthouse precinct is an architectural reminder of the need for constant vigilance by sea-farers.

In contrast to the near vertical grey and cream limestone cliffs of the south coast, the **North Coast** is all browns and reds. The shales and sandstones form rounded headlands which bookend deep bays with pasture rolling down to the sea. Each bay was settled early in the Island's history and accessed only by sea – careful observers can find signs of pioneer heritage.

Those familiar with the soft tannins and smooth mouth-feel of Bordeaux wines will be on firm ground at **Islander Estate Vineyard** – where French vigneron Jacques Lurton melds old world wine tradition with new world innovation. The "by appointment only" experience is from vine to glass and offers access and insight rarely found in a vineyard.

The rustic corrugated iron exterior of **Kangaroo Island Spirits (KIS)** belies the sophisticated palate and deft hand behind this small-batch distillery. Whilst remaining faithful to the botanical origins of gin, the creative couple behind KIS, John and Sarah Lark, have embraced the flavours and aromas imparted by locally sourced plant materials. This is one for the senses.

Honey, heritage and hard work are the three drivers of **Island Beehive**, a local enterprise which is part café, honey tasting, shop and food packaging plant. After trying the suite of seasonal honeys with flavours determined by the nectar foraged by busy bees, visitors get a backstage pass and follow the flow from the hive to the jar.
